Archery Alley

Organized by the North Carolina Bowhunters Association, Archery Alley allows kids to test their skills and technique in archery. Come experience the fun of archery with these professionals!

BB Gun Shoot

Young marksmen can test their skills at the Wake County Wildlife Club's BB gun shoot, located in the Jim Graham building. Winners take home the coveted, blaze orange Dixie Deer Classic hat – a long time tradition of the BB Gun Shoot!

Face Painting
