

Dixie Deer Classic Exhibitor Contract provisions and Show Rules and Regulations

If you are selected as an exhibitor for the 2015 Dixie Deer Classic you will be issued a contract for the exhibit space. The contract will include the following Terms and Show Rules and Regulations. This document is to make you aware of these provisions ahead of time so that when the contract is issued, there will be no surprises. Please review this document before completing the application process.

TERMS OF CONTRACT

PAYMENT: A non-refundable deposit of 20% of the projected rental amount is required to secure the booth reservation; the remaining **balance is due in full December 1, 2014. A late fee of 5% of the Balance Due will be assessed on December 2, 2014. All accounts not paid in full on January 1, 2015 will be canceled**, and all rights of the Exhibitor hereunder shall cease and terminate, **NO Exceptions**. Payments other than deposits are refundable if 15 days' notice of cancellation is given and only if the space is successfully re-leased. Neither this Contract nor its associated accounting is transferable. **All payments must be in U.S. funds.** Interim payments will be accepted, and are encouraged.

TERMINATION OF CONTRACT: This license may be terminated by the Wake County Wildlife Club at any time on the breach of any of the conditions by the Exhibitor, and thereupon all his rights hereunder shall cease and terminate, and any payments made by him on account hereof, prior to said termination, shall be retained by the Wake County Wildlife Club and may thereupon resell said space.

LIABILITY: The DIXIE DEER CLASSIC and the WAKE COUNTY WILDLIFE CLUB will not be liable for any loss or damage to property of Exhibitors, or its employees, due to fire, robbery, accidents, or any cause whatsoever that may arise from use and occupancy of leased space or building. The Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Dixie Deer Classic and the Wake County Wildlife Club and its employees and/or agents. **EXHIBITORS SHALL FURNISH THEIR OWN PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE to cover their actions and leased space.**

DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY: In case the premises are destroyed by fire or the elements, or by other cause, or in case of any circumstances whatsoever during the show, the booth exhibit fee cannot be refunded. The Wake County Wildlife Club is released from any and all claims for damages, which might arise upon consequence thereof. In the event, that, for any reason, the Dixie Deer Classic is not held as proposed, the Exhibitor shall receive a refund of any amounts paid on exhibit space other than deposits, releasing all claims or damage from the Wake County Club and/or its members.

SUBLETTING or donation of space, partially or in its entirety, is not permissible without the written consent of the show management. **Shared spaces must have ALL parties names included on the rental agreement.**

BUILDING RULES AND CITY ORDINANCES: The Exhibitor agrees to obey all rules of the North Carolina State Fairgrounds which may now be in existence or which hereafter may be made, and to abide by the rules and regulations of the Raleigh and Wake County Departments of Building, Fire, and Health, and such other Departments whose duties embrace regulations of exhibits, etc.

GENERAL: The management of the Dixie Deer Classic reserves the right to decline or prohibit any exhibit or portions thereof, and to permit only such, or conduct, as shall be approved by it. Show management reserves the right to make location/space changes, with no advance notice to the Exhibitor that will, in the opinion of show management, be of benefit to the show.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

MOVE IN, OPENING, AND CLOSING:

- Booths will be ready to install exhibits at 8:00 AM on Thursday.
- They must be open and manned from 11:00 AM to 9:00 PM on Friday; from 9:00 AM until 7:00 PM on Saturday; and from 9:00 AM until 5:00 PM on Sunday.
- Exhibits may not be dismantled prior to 5:00 PM Sunday, without written permission from show management.
- Exhibits *must* be removed from the building on Sunday evening.
- Exhibitors will have access to their exhibit space at least thirty (30) minutes prior to show opening each day.
- Vehicles entering the building to unload or load must display a **DDC Vehicle Pass**. All vehicles must exit the building prior to 10:30 AM on Friday, and will not be allowed in until 5:30 PM on Sunday, or when the Show Management deems it safe.

DECORATION and USE of EXHIBIT SPACE:

- All sales, taking of orders for future delivery, conferences, lectures, displays and distribution of literature will be

limited exclusively to Registered Exhibitors and must be conducted in a dignified manner, within the confines of leased space.

- Displays, projects and operations must be kept within the confines of the rented floor space.
- No booth structure, material or sign may extend more than ten feet in height on the back line or 3 feet in height on the side line for a distance of five feet from the front line, nor obstruct other displays or projects.
- No tents or canopies may be erected in indoor exhibit space without prior approval.
- All electrical use in the exhibit area must comply with the OSHA National Electrical Code.
- All exhibits must have attendants during show hours unless arrangements otherwise are made with show management. Show hours are 11:00 AM to 9:00 PM on Friday; 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM on Saturday; and 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM on Sunday
- Exhibitors should wear exhibitor identification at all times.
- Use of noise making devices, including game calls, or public address systems shall be under strict control of show management.
- Videotapes or DVDs to be shown during the show must be reviewed by the show management in advance to insure their content is in keeping with the show theme. Showing of unapproved videotapes or films is just cause for contract nullification, and subsequent eviction. Speaker volume must be maintained to a level deemed non-disruptive to adjoining exhibits by the show management.
- No cooking is allowed indoors.
- The sale of "Blow Guns" is prohibited.
- **No pets** or livestock are permitted without prior authorization. Dogs will only be permitted for exhibitors that are promoting dog training as their primary business.
- Any gasoline powered vehicles occupying indoor space must have the battery disconnected.
- Sale of merchandise displaying the Dixie Deer Classic logo is limited to the Wake County Wildlife Club and/or it's agents only.
- Exhibitors shall care for and keep in good order the space occupied by them and surrender such space at the close of the show in the same condition as it was when taken over. If the building or space occupied shall be damaged by the participants, his employees, patrons or guests, he shall pay such claims as are necessary to restore the space to its original condition.
- **Raffles** may only be conducted by chartered, NON-PROFIT organizations or charities (documented 501-C-3 or 501-C-4), and must be registered with the show. Drawing date and time must be clearly posted in the exhibit space.
- **Conduct:** Exhibitors and their personnel will be expected to maintain a businesslike attitude throughout the show, and strive to show the paying public a good time. **Consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly forbidden.** Anyone found to be creating a nuisance or conducting themselves in a manner unbecoming the Dixie Deer Classic will be subject to eviction from the premises.
- **Firearms** in displays that are accessible to the attending public must be secured in such a manner as to prevent any discharge. **The Dixie Deer Classic is a gun show**, but the public is strictly forbidden from bringing firearms into the show for any purpose. When you sell a firearm to a show patron, please advise him to take the weapon to his car immediately and then return to the show. Gun sales are not limited to the gun sales venue.

THE DECISION OF THE SHOW MANAGEMENT MUST BE ACCEPTED AS FINAL IN ANY DISPUTE BETWEEN EXHIBITORS OR ANY SITUATION NOT COVERED BY THESE RULES AND REGULATIONS.

In the application you will be required to enter the number that most closely corresponds to your type of business.

This does not exempt you from entering more specific details about your business in the “Products or Services” block. Outfitters need to list the country, state, province, territory, etc. in the block for “products and services”.
